SUBJECT: Senior Women's Competitions – Restrictions

With the recent restructure of the Women's Metro competitions, Football Gold Coast would like to remind teams of the restrictions on player movement between teams: -

- Clubs with teams in the Women's Brisbane Premier League & Reserves will only be eligible to drop Reserve grade players to Women's Metro (Division 1 & 2) to a maximum of 3 players per game (Reserve grade players are defined as playing 3 or less games in the Women's Brisbane Premier League First team).

This rule will change for the 2020 season and be noted in the CMC Rules in that Women's Premier League Reserves will only be eligible to drop to Women's Metro Division 1 to a maximum of 3 player per game.

- Clubs with teams in Women's Brisbane Premier League & Reserves are eligible to play their Women's Metro players up a maximum of 6 times per season (6 times in total outside their Metro team). Once a player plays her 7th game in WBPL/Res they will not be eligible to return to Women's Metro.

This rule will change for the 2020 season and be noted in the CMC Rules in that a Metro player can play a maximum of 4 games per season outside her nominated team. Once a player plays her 5th game in WBPL/Res they will not be eligible to return to Women's Metro.

- Players turning 18 years of age or less in 2019 are eligible to play unrestricted in all senior women's competitions.
