Dear Colleagues,

As you are all aware our season has been extended due to the impact of Covid 19 and as a result we have scheduled fixture games that will clash with the long time established Gold Coast Champions Cup and Premier Invitational tournaments.

These tournaments are being held on the Gold Coast and as such Football Gold Coast have endorsed both tournaments and are happy to make adjustments in the draw where needed to accommodate for local teams support and play in these tournaments.

Dates for tournaments are as follows:-

- Gold Coast Champions Cup – Mini Roos – 23<sup>rd</sup> Sept to 26<sup>th</sup> Sept.  
Juniors – 26<sup>th</sup> Sept to 3<sup>rd</sup> Oct.
- Premier Invitational – Various Age Groups – 21<sup>st</sup> Sept to 29<sup>th</sup> Sept.

Both tournaments are fast approaching and as such we would like to advise our clubs on the procedure for rescheduling fixtures should you wish to participate in either event.

FGC will be supportive of any reschedule request however we would like to reiterate that in order for a team to reschedule their fixture, the correct procedure must be followed.

Teams are required to put a game change request in on MyFGC as early as possible to ensure that all parties have the necessary time to organise the reschedule. Please don't leave this to the last minute as should any applications received outside the required time will not be considered.

Both clubs must agree to the game change request in order for it to be accepted and changed. For these fixture changes to be accepted and approved by FGC they **MUST** be rescheduled to a date **PRIOR** to the original fixture date.

We encourage all clubs who receive game change requests to be as accommodating as possible as the main aim of this season is to have our kids playing as much football as possible.
